**APPLICATION DEADLINE:** All applications, payment, and images must be received by May 31, 2025

**APPLICATION PROCESS:** All new applicants must provide three images of work to be exhibited and one image of your booth emailed to [artathbasf@gmail.com](mailto:artathbasf@gmail.com) in JPEG format. The Show Committee will “jury” all entries and notify applicants of acceptance. Once an artist is accepted, a contract will be forwarded with additional details.

**NOTIFICATION DATE:** Acceptance notifications will be mailed to all applicants by June 15<sup>th</sup>, 2025. Booth assignments will be provided via email in early October 2025.

**SPACE FEE:** \$350.00 per 10 x 14 booth space fee will be due by July 31, 2025. Do not pay before acceptance. A limited number of double spaces are available. NOTE: All tables, tents, etc. are the sole responsibility of the artist.
