APPLICATION DEADLINE: All applications, payment, and images must be received by May 31, 2026

APPLICATION FEE: \$30 non-refundable fee, payable at this link: blufftonartsandseafoodfestival.org/artists or by check. All checks should be addressed to: Art Committee, Historic Bluffton Arts and Seafood Festival, PO Box 2648, Bluffton, SC 29910

APPLICATION PROCESS: All applicants must provide a completed application and new applicants must also provide three images of work to be exhibited and one image of your booth emailed to artathbasf@gmail.com in JPEG format. The Show Committee will “jury” all entries and notify applicants of acceptance. Once an artist is accepted, a contract will be forwarded with additional details.

NOTIFICATION DATE: Acceptance notifications will be mailed to all applicants by June 15th, 2026. Booth assignments will be provided via email in early October 2026.

SPACE FEE: \$350.00 per 10' x 14' booth space fee will be due by July 31, 2026. Do not pay before acceptance. A limited number of double spaces are available. NOTE: All tables, tents, etc. are the sole responsibility of the artist.
